- The State Bank (SBV) publishes the results of surveying business trends of credit institutions (credit institutions). Fund mobilization of the whole credit institution system is expected to increase 3.4% on average in the fourth quarter and 8.7% in 2020.

- Foreign investors' trade was still quite negative as they net sold on all 3 exchanges with a total value of 241 billion dong. The selling focused on Bluechips such as MSN (-96.16 billion dong), VHM (-82.98 billion dong), VRE (-45 billion dong)...




## Top most traded tickers (Volume - in million)
