- At the end of February 16, US stocks were mixed, the S&P 500 left its historic peak in the context of rising bond yields, making investors worried. The S&P 500 lost a 0.4 percent gain and closed 0.1 percent lower at 3,932.59 points. Nasdaq Composite fell 0.3% to 14,047.50 points. The Dow Jones industrial average closed up 64.35 points, or 0.2%, to 31,522.75, hitting a record high.

- According to the latest macroeconomic report, VEPR offers two economic growth scenarios for Vietnam. VEPR is inclined to the baseline scenario the epidemic has not spread for most of the year and the domestic economy continues to operate normally with the gradual return to a normal state of the global economy. Economic growth for 2021 is forecasted at 5.6-5.8%.
- Foreign investors' trade was negative point when they continued to be net sellers on all 3 exchanges with a total value of VND 385 billion. The selling focused on Bluechips like VCB (-186.44 billion dong), HPG (-122.1 billion dong), and MBB (-87 billion dong) ...




