- Ending the February 18 session, US stocks simultaneously declined when investors were disappointed with the lower-than-expected unemployment data, as well as weak forecasts from Walmart. The Dow Jones industrial average fell 119.68 points, or 0.4%, to 31,493.34 points, slipping off a record high. At the intraday low, the 30-stock index fell more than 300 points. The S&P 500 fell 0.4 percent to 3,913.97 points, down for three consecutive sessions. Nasdaq Composite lost 0.7% to 13,865.36 class, as investors continued to leave the high-tech sector.

- According to preliminary statistics of the General Department of Customs, during the New Year's Day 2021 (7 days from February 10 to 16, 2021), the total value of import and export goods of the country reached 1.67. billion USD, up to 53% compared to the Lunar New Year in 2020.

- Foreign investors' trade was quite positive as they continued to net buy nearly 590 billion dong on the whole market, the buying power focused on Bluechips as well as ETFs.




