- Stock markets from Asia to Europe and the US all recovered strongly after a sharp drop at the end of last week, in the midst of a drop in US bond yields. In Japan, the Nikkei 225 increased by nearly 700 points (equivalent to 2.41%) to 29,663.50 points, after falling nearly 4% on February 26. The Topix index jumped 2.04% to 1,902.48, a bright March start.

- The IIP in February 2021 is estimated to decrease by 21.1% from the previous month and to decrease by 7.2% over the same period last year. The mining industry decreased by 18.5% and down by 23%; processing and manufacturing decreased 23.1% and decreased 5.8%; electricity production and distribution decreased 9.8% and 2.3%; water supply, waste and wastewater management and treatment decreased 8.7% and increased 0.1%.






## Top most traded tickers (Volume - in million)
