


Content - VPB: Deputy General Director Nguyen Thanh Binh registered to sell 160,000 shares, reducing the holding to 196,990 units. The transaction is expected to be done via order matching, from April 29 to May 28.

- NVL: Listed 4,744,375 additional shares due to the international convertible bond issue of Nova Real Estate Investment Corporation. Date of listing change: April 29, 2021
- The US WTI crude oil price increased by 0.13% at 7:05 (GMT) on April 28. While the price of Brent crude oil delivered in June fell 0.14% to \$ 65.94/barrel.
- VRE: Q1.2021, total consolidated net revenue in the first three months of the year reached 2,226 billion dong, up 32% compared to the first quarter of 2020.
- VNM: Platinum Victory PTE.LTD did not buy any of the nearly 21 million registered shares.
- FPT: In Q1.2021, FPT recorded nearly 7,600 billion dong of revenue and nearly 1,400 billion dong of profit before tax, up 14.4 percent and 22.3 percent. Among the components, the technology sector contributes 55% to revenue and 40% to total profit before tax. Newly signed sales of the technology sector reached more than VND 5,800 billion, the highest level in the last 4 quarters and increased more than 46% compared to the same period last year.
