- At the end of the week, the Dow Jones rose 1.2%, the S&P 500 up 1.4% and the Nasdag increases 1.1%. This is the fourth consecutive week of increase for the S&P 500 and Dow Jones. This week, the S&P 500 peaked at 3 sessions. 9/11 sectors in the S&P 500 closed on April 16 in the green, except for energy and information technology. Investors' confidence in the future appears to be stable, with the CBOE VIX index measuring fear on Wall Street plunging 1.9% to a 14-month low.



- The GSO has just released a report on the labor and employment situation in the first quarter, in which 9.1 million people were negatively affected by the Covid-19 epidemic. Specifically, 540,000 people lost their jobs; 2.8 million people have to temporarily stop or suspend production and business; 3.1 million workers have their working hours cut or forced to take time off, take turns, and 6.5 million workers have their incomes reduced.

- The negative point of the market last week was that both foreign and proprietary trading of securities companies were net sellers. Accordingly, proprietary trading securities companies have been net sellers for 5 consecutive weeks with VND 1,450 billion. Foreign investors continued to net sell 135 billion dong on HoSE, down 61% from the previous week
