The Chinese market could not hold its momentum, closing in the red with the Shanghai Composite down 0.65% and the Shenzhen Component down 1.95%. Hong Kong's Hang Seng decreased by 0.44%. In South Korea, the Kospi increased by 0.58%.





Foreign net flow 10 nearest sessions (Billion VND)


