

- The data released by the GDC shows that, in the first four months of 2021, the total import and export value reached \$208.25b, up 30.7% over the same period last year. The value of exported goods reached \$104.94b, up 29.6%, corresponding to an increase of \$23.94b and imports reached \$103.31b, up 31.8%, corresponding to an increase of \$24.92b. With this result, Vietnam continues to have a trade surplus of \$1.63b.




Content
- VPB: VPBank has fixed the maximum foreign ownership ratio at 15%, which according to regulations, the total ownership of foreign investors in Vietnamese commercial banks cannot exceed 30%.

- KDH: Vietnam Ventures Limited- belonging to VOF fund managed by VinaCapital, registered to sell 7.7m KDH shares. The transaction is expected to be carried out from May 20 to June 18
- The price of WTI crude oil increased by 1.58% to \$66.39 per barrel at 5:15 am (GMT) on May 18. The price of Brent crude oil delivered in July was unchanged at 69.58 USD/barrel.
- VRE: In 2021, VRE is expected to continue to provide the market with nearly 100,000 m2 of retail floor space, bringing the total retail floor area of the system to 1.8 million m2.
- MSN: Alibaba and Baring invest \$400 million in Masan's The CrownX, valued at \$7.3 billion
- HPG: Mr. Tran Vu Minh, Son of HPG Chairman, registered to buy 5 million HPG shares. The transaction period is from May 21, 2021 to June 18, 2021. If the transaction is successful, Mr. Minh will own 53 million HPG shares, equivalent to 1.6%.


## Top most traded tickers (Volume - in million)




# Foreign net flow 10 nearest sessions (Billion VND)
