

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
Content
- Recently, many banks have offered to sell a lot of debt with a starting price that has been drastically reduced compared to the total debt repayment obligation. Many debts have been offered for sale by Sacombank many times, the next time the price is lower than the previous one, some debts have been reduced by nearly 50% of the total debt repayment obligation but have not yet been liquidated.

- KDH: some internal members such as Deputy Director, member of the Supervisory Board... bought a total amount of 731,000 shares issued ESOP
- Gas price today (June 29) increased by nearly 0.3% to \$3.59/mmBTU for natural gas contract for July 2021 delivery at 9:10 am (Vietnam time).
- VIC: Sell electric cars, lease batteries, target 15,000 cars in the US next year
- MSN: VinCommerce has an after-tax profit of VND 3,222 billion. Owner's equity recorded VND 2,688 billion. The ratio of liabilities to equity is 4.75 times.
- VJC: Vietjet's Board of Directors submits to shareholders for approval of a private placement of shares with a maximum of 15% of charter capital in the period of 2021 2022. The airline also intends to issue a maximum of USD 300 million in international bonds. Vietjet plans to issue 10 million ESOP shares at 10,000 VND/share. The dividend rate in 2020 is expected to be 50% in shares.


## Top most traded tickers (Volume - in million)
