- China announced August CPI, Asian stocks fell. In Japan, the Nikkei 225 fell 0.26%. The Chinese market rose with Shanghai Composite up 0.49%, Shenzhen Component up 0.07%. Hong Kong's Hang Seng fell 1.4%. China's consumer price index (CPI) in August rose 0.8 percent year-on-year, lower than analysts' forecast for a 1 percent increase. The producer price index (PPI) in August increased by 9.5%, surpassing the forecast for an increase of 9%. South Korea's Kospi index fell 1.53%.




### Top most traded tickers (Volume - in million)
