- The Dow Jones Industrial Average fell back on Friday and the S&P 500 retreated from record highs after the August jobs report fell short of expectations, showing the impact of a rise in the number of stocks. Covid-19 Delta variant infection. Closing the session, the Dow Jones lost 74.73 points (0.21%) to 35,369.09 points, while the S&P 500 index lost 0.03% to 4,535.43 points after holding a slight gain in the afternoon session. The market was supported by technology stocks, which helped the Nasdaq Composite advance 0.21% to 15,363.50 points.

- According to the announcement of the State Treasury, from next week, there will be a term buy-back of government bonds with all working days of the week, from September 6 to September 10, the most popular tenors are 14 and 21 days; The shortest term is 7 days and the longest is 3 months. Thus, with terms ranging from 1-3 months, commercial banks - the main target audience - have a longer option in source balance

- Compared to the end of July, the number of DR DCVFM VN30 ETF listed on SET has increased by 19.9 million units, equivalent to 734.3 million Bath (about 516 billion VND). Contrary to the trend of capital attraction in August of the DCVFM VN30 ETF, the largest ETF in Vietnam, the DCVFM VNDiamond ETF, saw a net withdrawal of nearly VND720 hillion in August
