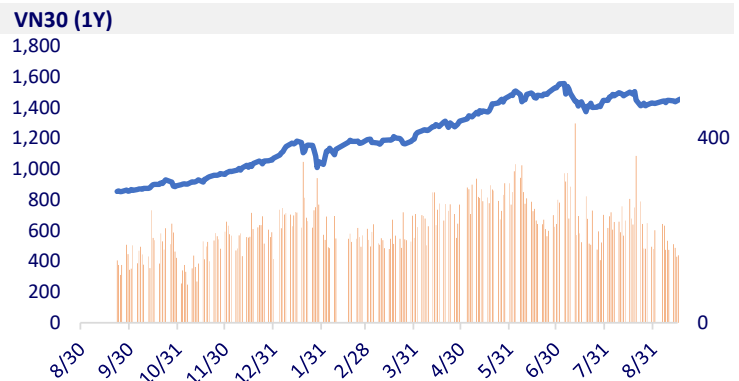
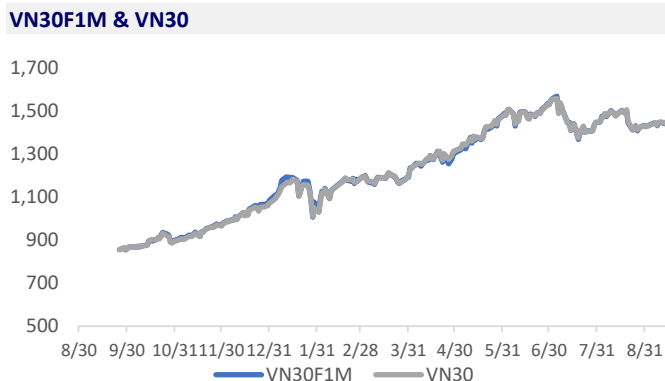

The S&P 500 index advanced nearly 1% to 4,395.64 points as the energy sector jumped 3.2%. The S&P 500 also recorded its first gain in five sessions. Nasdaq Composite added 1% to 14,896.80 points

Industrial production reached 6.3%, up more than 2%. In the second quarter, the gross domestic product (GRDP) reached 5.91%, up nearly 3%
