- US stocks rallied on Friday (October 1), as investors closed a difficult September and news of a new oral treatment for Covid-19 boosted shares of the companies associated with the economic recovery. At the end of the session, the Dow Jones index rose 482.54 points (equivalent to 1.43%) to 34,326.46 points. The S&P 500 gained nearly 1.2% to 4,357.05, while the Nasdaq Composite added 0.8% to 14,566.70, ending a streak of five consecutive losses.



- The Alliance of Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs) has just submitted a Letter of Recommendation to the Prime Minister to direct the Ministry of Finance to set up a Loan Guarantee Fund for these businesses, with a limit of up to VND 100,000 billion... - In the week of September 27 - October 1, individuals net sold through order matching of 196 billion dong due to the cautious sentiment when the market lacked positive information. The focus of the transaction was the net selling of 451 billion dong of VNM shares, equivalent to a volume of more than 5 million shares.
