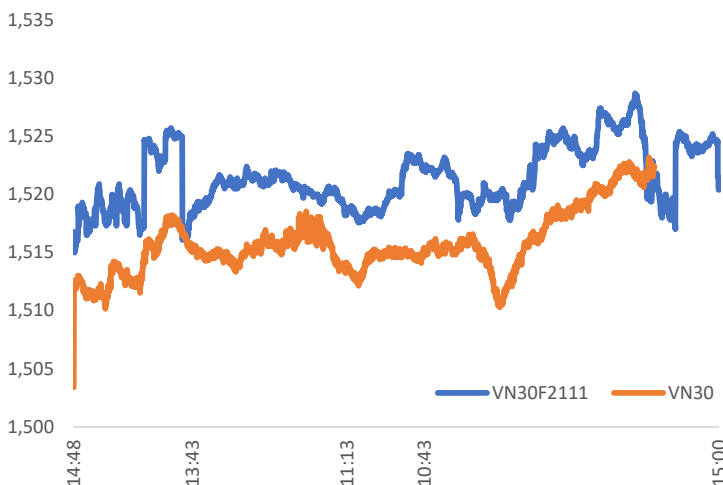
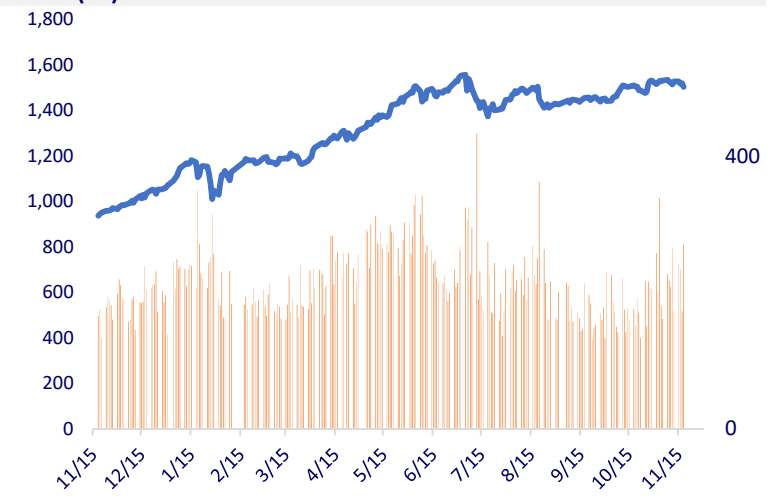
- The S&P 500 index rose in a volatile session on Thursday (November 18) following strong earnings results from Nvidia, the world's largest chipmaker by market value, and retail businesses is different. Closing the session, the S&P 500 added 0.3% to 4,704.64 and the Nasdaq Composite added 0.5% to 15,993.70. The Dow Jones Industrial Average fell 60 points, or 0.1%, to 35,870.95, pressured by a sharp drop in Cisco shares. At one point during the session the S&P 500 fell as much as 0.3% before recovering.

- Despite many challenges from the Covid-19 pandemic, Vietnam's stock market has had a remarkable development, along with the development of businesses and the economy, attracting a large number of investors. According to statistics of the Securities Commission, by September 30 this year, the total market size has reached more than 8 million 300 trillion dong, equivalent to more than 133% of the country's GDP.
