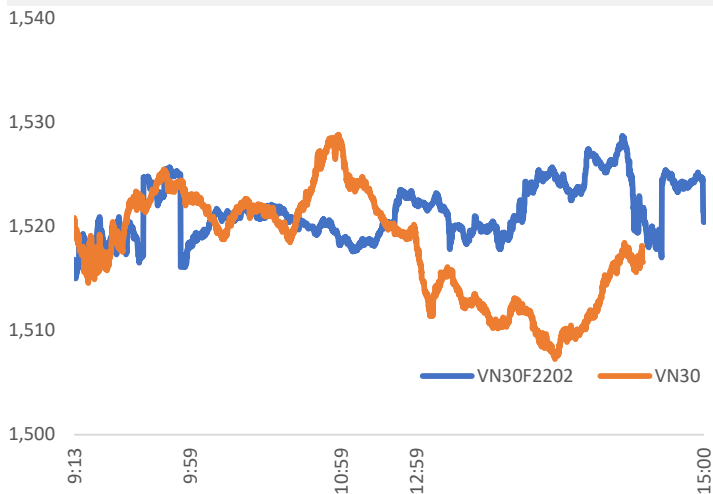
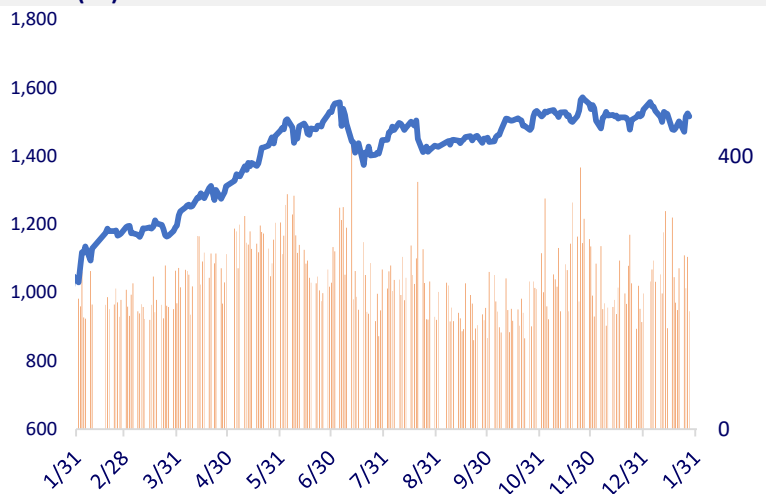

At the end of the session, the Dow Jones was mostly unchanged at 34,160.78 points, after jumping more than 600 points at the peak of the session. The S&P 500 fell 0.5% to 4,326.50, and the Nasdaq Composite lost 1.4% to 13,352.80. Both indices rallied at the beginning of the session
