

On the other side, VHM was sold the most on this floor with 51 billion dong, VIC was also net sold 46 billion dong

This is the second consecutive month that Vietnam recorded a decrease in total newly registered FDI capital. Among them, the number of newly registered projects reached USD 3.21b, up nearly 38% in number of projects but decreased by nearly 56% in capital compared to


