

Foreign investors continued to net buy 450 billion dong on May 31. Foreign investors were still strong net buyers of domestic ETF certificates FUEVFVND with 215 billion dong. VHM and DGC were net bought 63 billion dong and 47 billion dong respectively. Meanwhile, fund certificates E1VFVN30 were sold the most with 98 billion dong. PNJ and DPM were net sold at 67 billion dong and 55 billion dong respectively.

In mainland China, the Shanghai Composite Index rose 1.19%. Hong Kong's Hang Seng Index rose 1.66%. In Japan, the Nikkei 225 index fell 0.09%. South Korea's Kospi index rose 0.61%.

The IIP in May increased by 10.4%, even higher than the two years before the epidemic, 2018 and 2019. Notably, Bac Giang also increased by 43%, Bac Ninh was 20%, on the basis of May last year was significantly affected by the epidemic. Equally notable is the total retail sales of consumer goods and services in May when it increased by 22.6% over the same period, which means that the scale of increase is also higher than the same period in the previous years. 
