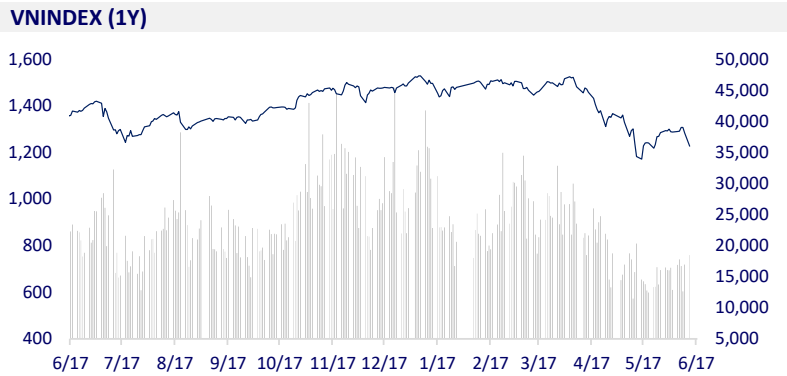
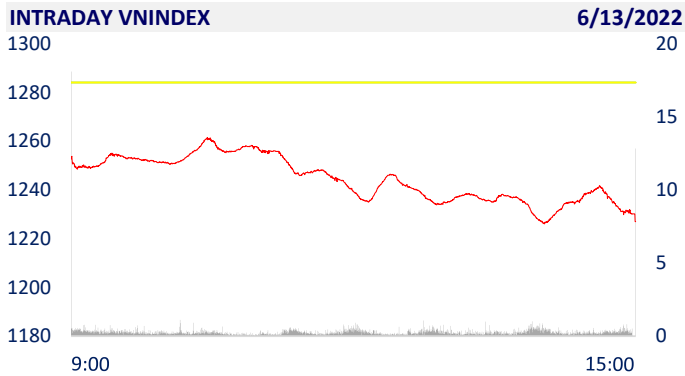
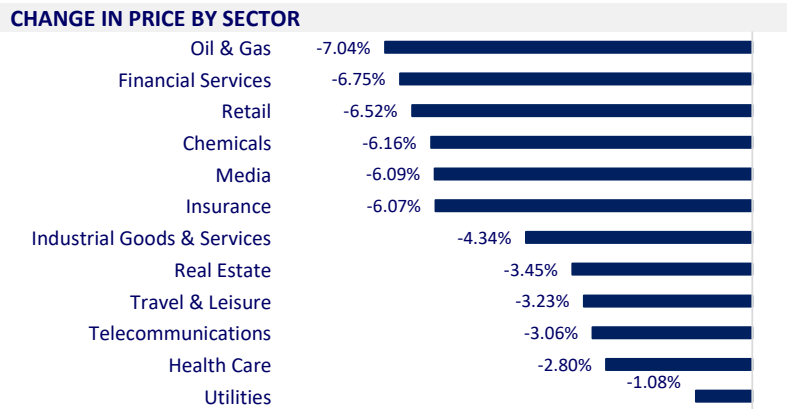

In 2021, the US Treasury Department concluded that there were no major partners manipulating currencies in 2021.

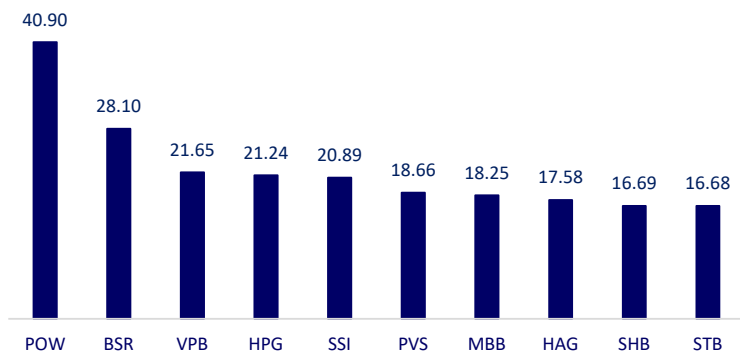

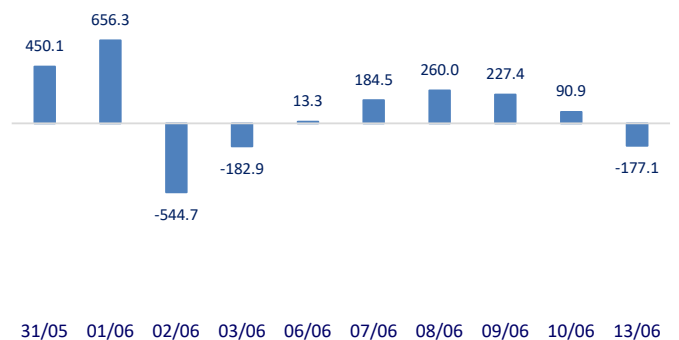

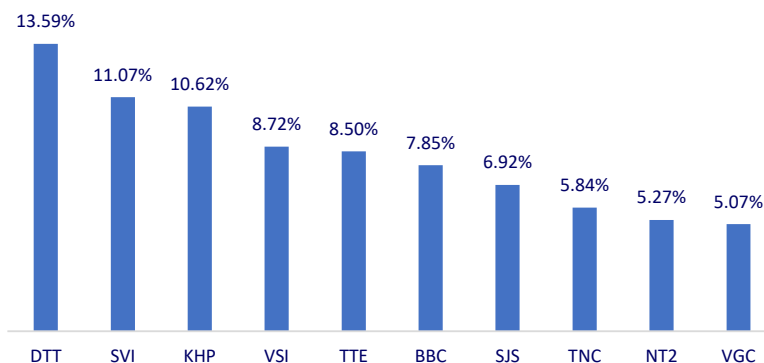
Top most traded tickers (Volume - in million)
