

Foreign investors bought 44.8 million shares, worth 1,675 billion dong, while selling 54 million shares, worth 1,847 billion dong. Total net selling volume was at 9.4 million shares, equivalent to a net selling value of 191 billion dong. DGC was sold the most by foreign investors on HoSE with 88.7 billion dong.










Top decreases in 3 consecutive sessions
