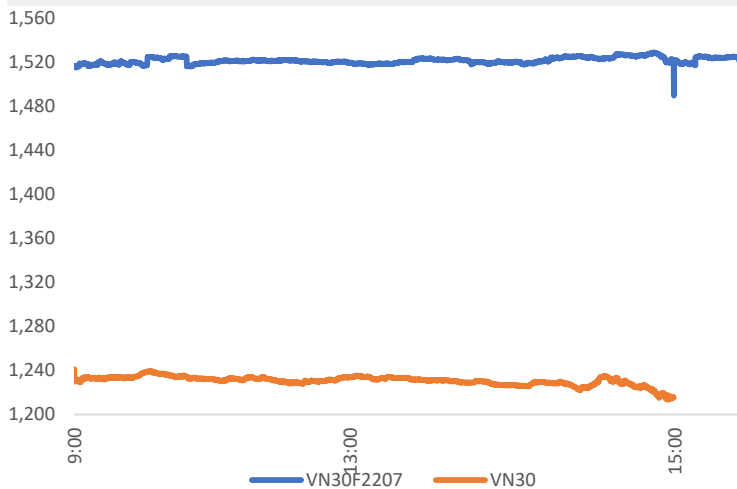
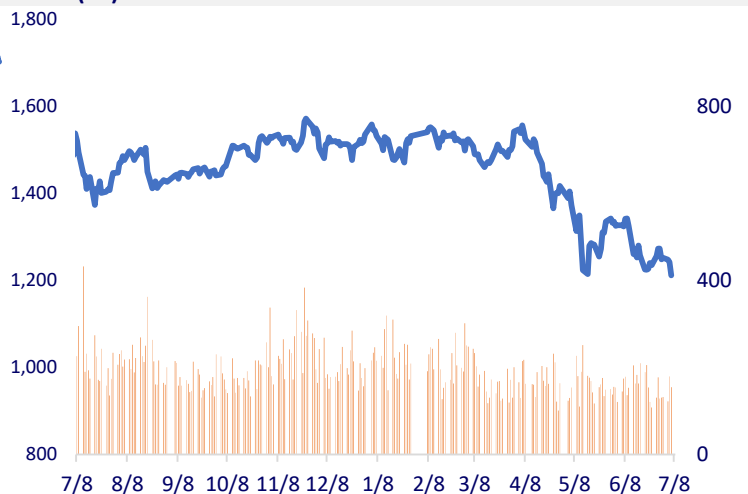

At the end of the session, the Dow Jones index rose 69.86 points (or 0.23%) to 31,037.68 points. The S&P 500 index advanced 0.36% to 3,845.08 points. The Nasdaq Composite added 0.35% to 11,361.85 points.
