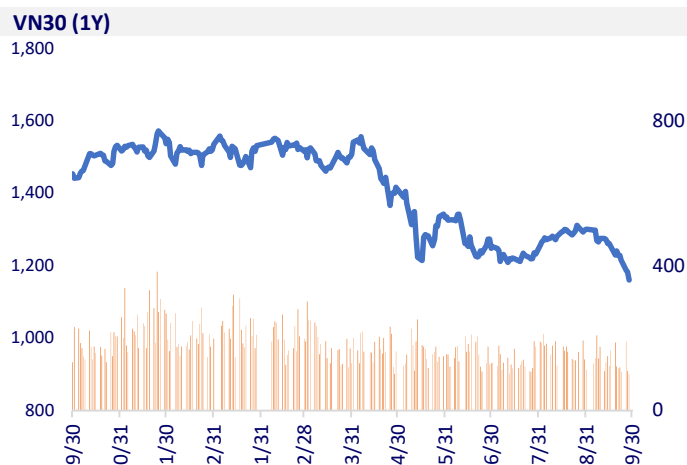
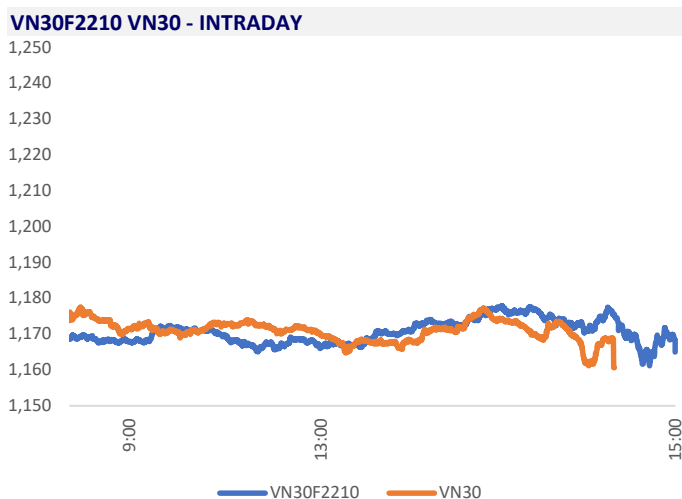

The Dow Jones Industrial Average rose 1.88% to 29,683.74 points. The S&P 500 rose 1.97% to 3,719.04 points, a day after recording a new bear market low
