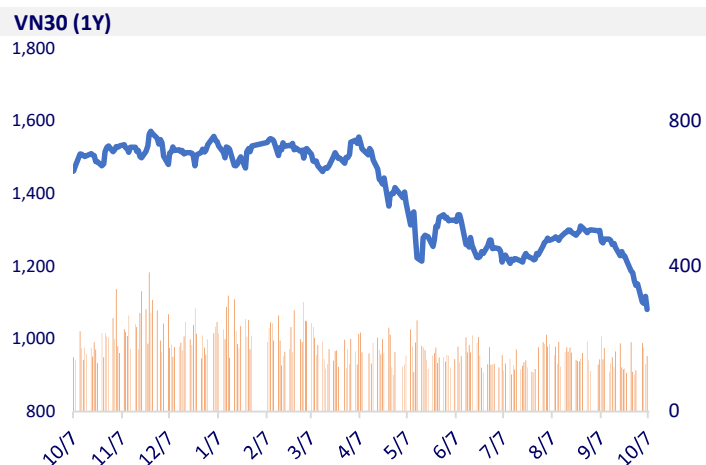
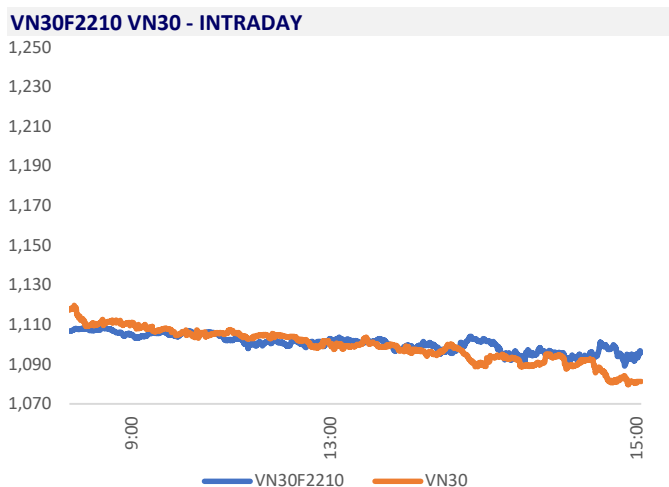

Ending Thursday's session, the DJIA fell 1.15% to 29,926.94 points. The S&P 500 index lost 1.02% to 3,744.52 points, the Nasdaq Composite dropped 0.68% to 11,073.31 points. These 3 indexes all opened the session in red. However, all three indexes are aiming to record a gain of more than 4% in the past week, marking the best weekly gain since June 24, 2022

In September, the total state budget revenue managed by tax authorities was estimated at VND 78,200 billion, reaching 6.7% of the ordinance estimate, up 29.1% over the same period last year
