U.S. stocks ended with modest losses on Monday, as the focus shifted after last week's Al-fueled rally to upcoming economic data that could affect the timing of the Federal Reserve's expected interest rate cut. Warren Buffett-led Berkshire Hathaway dipped 1.94%, erasing early gains on investor worries after the U.S. government warned of a lawsuit against its power company, PacifiCorp. Domino's Pizza opens new tab jumped 5.85% after surpassing Wall Street expectations for quarterly same-store sales.



Oil prices ticked up in early Asian trading, extending gains for the third straight day, as shipping disruptions spurred supply worries. Iranaligned Houthis have continued their attacks on shipping in the Red Sea, it has increased freight rates and shipping time, leaving barrels on the water for longer.
