The Dow Jones Industrial Average declined on Wednesday (June 4), following U.S. nonfarm employment change data hitting its lowest level in over two years. The weak figures have amplified concerns that ongoing uncertainty in trade policies may be putting pressure on the U.S. economy.


According to estimates by analysts at Goldman Sachs, central banks worldwide are accumulating around 80 tons of gold per month, equivalent to approximately USD8.5 billion at current prices. Much of this buying is carried out discreetly, with trade data indicating that China is among the primary purchasers, alongside other unidentified buyers transacting through Switzerland.

VN-Index experienced sharp fluctuations near its previous peak, triggered by unconfirmed reports regarding Vietnam-U.S. trade talks. Proprietary recorded a net sell of VND23 billion, focusing on stocks like GEX (VND103 billion), TCB (VND22 billion), and VCB (VND10 billion). In contrast, they net bought FPT (VND58 billion), VHM (VND27 billion), and MBB (VND10 billion).
