On September 15, U.S. stocks rose after President Donald Trump stated that U.S.-China trade talks were going well. Specifically, the two countries discussed tariffs and deadlines related to the sale of TikTok. Trump said the meeting between officials was positive and that an agreement "had also been reached regarding a 'certain' company that young people in our country really want to save," likely referring to TikTok. Reuters quoted a senior official saying that the U.S. would maintain the TikTok ban if China withdrew its request for tariff reductions and technology restrictions.

On September 15, 2025, in London, Finance Minister Nguyễn Văn Thắng and a delegation from the Ministry of Finance met with the London Stock Exchange (LSE) and FTSE Russell. Under the witness of Minister Thắng and leaders of both sides, the Vietnam Stock Exchange (VNX) signed a memorandum of understanding (MoU) with FTSE International Limited, officially establishing a strategic partnership aimed at enhancing capital market infrastructure and promoting international integration.

VN-Index surged strongly and closed at the day's high, with liquidity improving across multiple sectors. Proprietary trading desks of securities firms recorded a net sell of 134 billion VND on September 15, primarily in HPG (88 billion VND), MBB (65 billion VND), VCG (49 billion VND), and MSN (47 billion VND). In contrast, they posted net buys in FPT (119 billion VND) and SSI (41 billion VND).
