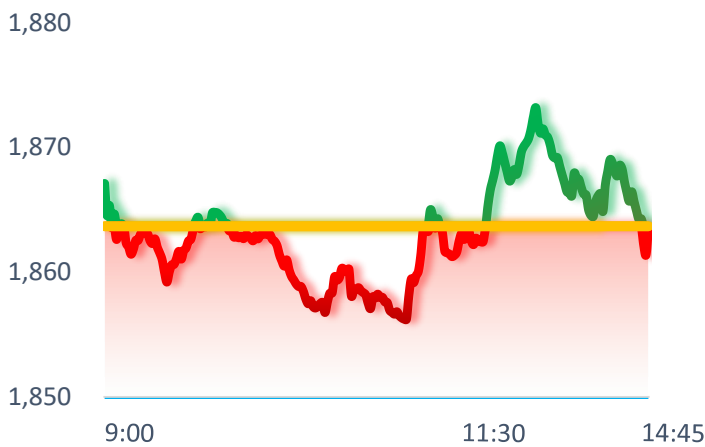
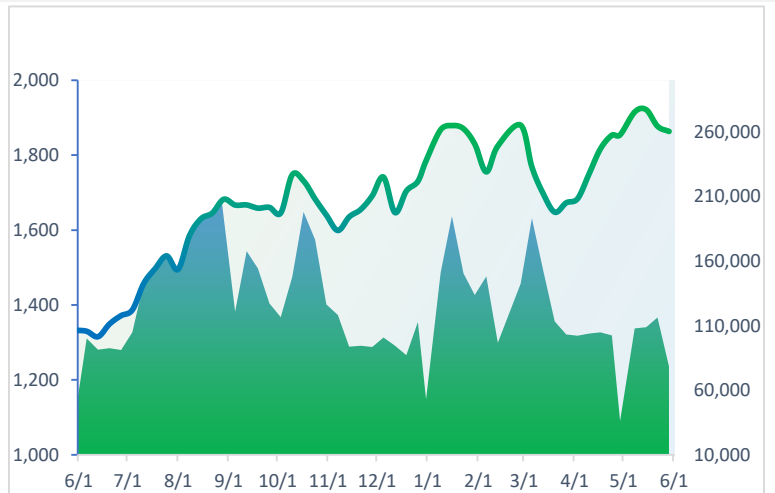

Dell Technologies was the biggest gainer, jumping nearly 33%, recording its best trading day ever, after the laptop maker reported first-quarter results that beat expectations in both revenue and profit, and raised its full-year forecast.
